School Exhibit Program at NWSF

Rules

1. NWSF will follow all rules set by ATCP 160 County and District Fairs State of Wisconsin Administrative Code. General Requirements 160.01-.09 and ATCP.80 Educational and School Exhibits; department 35 and ATCP 160.91-160.93.
2. Only Chippewa County Schools are eligible to exhibit.
3. Each student and/or teacher is assigned an exhibitor number. Teachers who work in more than one school should get a number from one school and enter all projects under that number. No teacher can have more than one exhibitor number regardless of how many schools or classrooms they work in. (See attached list.)
4. Individual student work shall be entered under an assigned student number.
5. Group work (Five or more individuals created exhibit) or exhibits consisting of work made by five or more individual students shall be entered under the teacher's assigned number.
6. A student or teacher may only enter one exhibit under each lot number. Duplicate entries will be disqualified.
7. Exhibits shall fit the lot description. If a project is entered under Reading Project lot number, it should clearly reflect the content of a reading project. If it is hard to interpret its relevance to the lot, attach an explanation why it is entered under that lot number. Entries not fitting category will be disqualified.
8. Every exhibitor (students and teachers) must submit a completed entry form. Be sure to use first and last names (no Mr(s). Smith).
9. An entry tag must be attached to the front, lower right-hand corner of each exhibit. The tag shall have the exhibitor number, grade and lot number written on it. Be sure they are securely attached as summer heat and humidity can soften adhesives. Staples, clips or strong tape work the best.
10. All exhibits must have exhibitors name and school clearly written on the back of the exhibit.
11. NWSF is not responsible for lost, broken or damaged exhibits.

Procedure

1. Teachers should keep excellence in mind throughout the school year gathering student work to exhibit at the NWSF.
2. Each school is assigned a bank of exhibitor's numbers. Give only one number to each student or teacher, regardless of how many exhibits they enter. (See attached list)
3. Each school is provided with student and teacher (group) entry forms, entry tags and premium lists. More can be duplicated as needed. Blank entry forms, entry tags and the premium list can also be found on the NWSF website at www.northernwistatefair.com.
4. Fill out entry forms completely. Do not use Mr. or Mrs. For teacher's names. A legal first name must be given in order to issue premium checks.
5. Submit completed entry forms to NWSF office at: 10 South Bridge Street, Chippewa Falls, WI or mail them to P.O. Box 48 Chippewa Falls, WI 54729. No late entries will be accepted. **Deadline for 2011 Fair is 6-12- 2011.**
6. Exhibits will be accepted at the fairgrounds on Monday, June 6, 2011 through Monday, June 13, 2011 from 9AM-4 PM. Be sure all exhibits have an entry tag attached in the lower right hand corner of the exhibit and the student or teachers name and school is clearly written on the back of the exhibit.
7. Exhibits must be picked up after the Fair on Tuesday, July 19, 2011 from 9AM-4PM in the RCU School Building on the Fairgrounds. Premium checks will also be available for pick up at this time in the Entry Office on the Fairgrounds.
